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- Our annual Great Value Sires issue. Fifteen Sires, seven in NA and eight in EU, headed by Coolmore's F2016 **Australia** for €10,000 in Europe and Airdrie's F2020 **Collected** for \$10,000 in Kentucky. Plus two very promising Sire Classes, 11 F2024 sires in Kentucky and eight retiring F2026 sires in Europe.
- European 2nd-Half Mixed Sales review. A record 134-million gns at the Tattersalls December Sale leading a record €325-million in the European Mixed Sales (we distinguish 2nd-half from 1st-half mixed sales as the Jan/Feb mixed sales were 2023 coverings & 2023 foals whereas the 2nd-half mixed sales are 2024 coverings & 2024 foals). Five foals by **Frankel** averaged \$1,518,640 headed by the European record-equaling 2.5-million gns full sister to Chaldean.
- Worldwide Sales Tickers covering the European 2nd-half Mixed Sale markets and combined North American 2nd-half mixed sales which all together totaled €638-million.

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SECTION 1: VALUE SIRES FOR 2025

GREAT VALUE SIRES FOR 2025: LUCKY 15 PLUS TWO SIRE CLASSES

If you own a mare with the intention of keeping her and trying to make her into a successful broodmare, the ultimate objective must be to produce good, if not black-type, racehorses. If you own a mare with intention of flipping her and you want to breed her to the sexiest, most commercial horse you can find so you can sell her in foal next year, skip this article. When we're talking about 'great value for 2025' we mean to try and produce a racehorse, whether it's a good move commercially or not.

In this issue we've selected 15 sires in North America and Europe who we think represent particularly good value for 2025 – seven in North America and eight in Europe. We tout four sires in Kentucky with Midyear 2024 APEX Ratings (sires with 3yo's+ of 2024), and four in Europe, and three sires in Kentucky with 2yo's and under, and four in Europe; plus two sire classes which include a number of (in our opinion) particularly good prospects.

North America

I thought last year that Ashford's **American Pharoah** at \$50,000 was just about the best value going so at \$45,000 for 2025 I don't see any reason to change my mind. Okay, he's not Justify but 'Pharoah' was the first Triple Crown winner in 37 years and he's done quite well as a sire too, particularly when we compare him with Constitution, the other top North American sire with first foals 2017, who stands for more than twice as much as American Pharoah at \$110,000. Constitution has 45 BTW, 92 BTH, 22 GSW, 52 GSH but just 2 G1W and 12 G1H. 'Pharoah' has 46 BTW, 86 BTH, 21 GSW, 42 GSH, 7 G1W and 17 G1H. He has a 2.07 A Runner Index (Constitution, in fairness, is 2.82) and 61% of his BTW are on turf (Constitution is 40%).

Another F2017 sire who continues to offer great value – possibly because 82% (14) of his 17 BTW are on turf – is Gainesway's 2014 G1 Breeders' Cup Mile winner **Karakontie** at \$15,000. These turf BTW include his three best horses, all fillies: G1W Spendarella and She Feels Pretty (in 2024) and G2W Princess Grace, who brought \$1.7-million at the 2022 Fasig-Tipton 'Night of the Stars' sale and has placed in two G1's and two G2's in Australia for the China Horse Club.

Airdrie Stud stands two horses, both F2020 sires with first 4yo's 2024, who rank right at the top of the list: **Girvin** (\$25,000) and **Collected**, who at \$10,000 walks away with our award as North America's Very Best Value Sire for 2025. #4 Freshman Sire **Complexity** (\$25,000) merits Honorable Mention, too. Girvin won the G2 Risen Star, G2 Louisiana Derby, and G1 Haskell as a 3yo in 2017. He started out for \$7,500 for his first two seasons at Ocala Stud in Florida, \$6,000 for his next two seasons, but earned a move to Kentucky after coming #5 on the 2022 North American Freshman Sire List including G1W Faiza, a \$725,000 Maryland 2yo who won five of six including the G1 Starlet and G2 Santa Anita Oaks, and sold to Godolphin for \$4-million at the 2023 Fasig November Sale. Girvin had only 36 named foals in his fourth and final Florida crop, now 2yo's, but they include recent Tempted S. winner Stunner. Girvin sports an impressive 2.40 A Runner Index and a monster 3.93 ABC 2yo Index and will be covering his third Kentucky crop in 2025; in our view he qualifies as a proven sire at an unproven sire price.

Collected, one of the last sons of City Zip at stud, on the other hand has been at Airdrie for his whole stud career. Trained by Baffert for Speedway Stable, he won the G3 Sham and G3 Lexington as a 3yo in the spring of 2016 but after finishing 10th of 11 in the G1 Preakness he was off for the remainder of the year. He came back to win his first four races as a 4yo, including the G1 Pacific Classic, and followed that up by running 2nd to none other than Gun Runner in the 2017 G1 Breeders' Cup Classic. He started out at \$17,500, dropped to \$15,000 in his fourth year, then dropped again to \$10,000 after finishing 14th on the 2022 Freshman Sire List. But his second crop includes eight BTW 3yo's and he has 18 current 2yo winners including 3 BTW, 2 of them GSW. He only covered 53 mares this season but deserves for that book size to double in 2025.

Thousand Words, the #5 Freshman Sire with 18 winners including G3W The Queen's M.G. and Churchill Downs Debutante S. winner Vodka With a Twist, subsequently 2nd in the G1 Del Mar Debutante and G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, was a \$1-million Keeneland September yearling who raced for the

Albaugh Family and Spendthrift Farm, where he stands. Like American Pharoah a son of Pioneerof The Nile trained by Baffert, Thousand Words won his first three starts, including the G2 Los Al Futurity and G3 Robert Lewis. But he was a 3yo in the Covid year 2020 and not much went right for him after the Lewis, his only win in six subsequent starts coming in the Shared Belief S. at Del Mar, in which he defeated Honor A.P. He stood his first two seasons for \$7,500, then dropped to \$5,000 for the next two, and still looks awfully good value with a raise to just \$12,500 for 2025. He still covered 98 mares this year in his fourth season.

In his 11 starts as a 4yo-6yo (1 start in January when 2nd in the G1 Pegasus to Life Is Good) for Brad Cox, Taylor Made's **Knicks Go** won 8 races including winning Beyers of 107+ six times, was once 2nd and twice 4th. He won the Breeders' Cup G1 Dirt Mile as a 4yo and followed that up with a win in the G1 Pegasus in January as a 5yo and came back later in 2021 to win the G1 Whitney and G1 Breeders' Cup Classic, earning Horse of the Year honors. Ordinarily horses who get good going two turns as 4- or 5yo's aren't great sire prospects but Knicks Go has a hole card: in 14 starts as a 2yo and 3yo for Ben Colebrook he won the G1 Breeders' Futurity and ran 2nd to Game Winner in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile. From a crop of 118 rising 2yo's he had 60 yearlings sell this year for a \$56,091 average. He's eligible to surprise a few people and if he does that \$12,500 fee for 2025 is going to look like a big bargain.

Lane's End's **Up to the Mark** is one of three Champion sons of Not This Time who will be standing at stud in Kentucky in 2025, along with Ashford's 2022 Champion 3yo Colt Epicenter, whose first foals have sold this year, and WinStar's Cogburn, who is a cinch to be named Champion Turf Sprinter. F2018 Not This Time is in the same class as F2019 Gun Runner and F2020 Justify as

the three best younger proven sires in Kentucky and these three champions tell you why and also testify to his versatility as a sire. Up to the Mark, it must be conceded, was a two-turn turf horse who got good as a 4yo. But he got really good, winning the G1 Turf Classic at 9f at Churchill Downs, the G1 Manhattan at 10f at Belmont, and the G1 Turf Mile at Keeneland before running a winning losing race in the 2023 G1 Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita, when Ryan Moore cut the corner on Auguste Rodin; if he hadn't got the split Up to the Mark was a sure winner, and he was rightfully named Champion Turf Male at the Eclipse Awards. But what we think makes him a really genuine prospect to make a sire was just how good he got; Oscar Performance, who once ran 1m at Belmont Park in 1:31:1/5 and was a G1 winner on turf at two, three, and four, proves a top turf horse really can succeed at stud in North America if they're good enough. Up to the Mark was that good, and so was Golden Pal, at Ashford, and Cogburn, going to WinStar, who broke a minute for 5 1/2 f at Saratoga this summer. The More Than Looks – Johannes G1 Breeders' Cup Mile exacta shows that race is no longer the exclusive domain of European readers, and Up to the Mark nearly proved that himself against August Rodin in the Turf. Up to the Mark covered 164 mares in his first season this year, and second season, two turns, turf, whatever – he really did have the ability to prove way better than his \$25,000 stud fee for 2025.

North America: The Class of '24

One of the most important elements of stallion analysis we've used for decades is to divide sires into groups based on their age of oldest foals – for example, all sires who had their first foals in 2006 (denoted F2006 sires). Separating the population of sires into their 'F-years' enables us to compare them to their contemporaries who in key ways have had the same opportunity, rather than trying to compare them to the entire population of sires which may stretch across 15 or 20 years. One thing we've learned from doing this is there are on average about 2 1/2 really good sires in each 'sire crop' – the aforementioned F2006 group of North American sires in fact turned out to include four stallions who became Top Ten sires over the last 15 years – three-time champion sire Tapit; Medaglia d'Oro; Speightstown; and Candy Ride. That was a vintage crop.

It seems to us that the group of North American stallions who went to stud in 2023 and had their first foals this year (F2024 sires) has the potential to become another vintage crop: there are no fewer than eleven stallions with really good credentials to become successful sires. Not coincidentally they were the eleven first-crop weanling sires with the highest averages at the November sales. They are headed by "America's Frankel" – 2022 unbeaten Horse of the Year **Flightline** – and **Life is Good**, who would have been Horse of the Year if he hadn't come along the same year as Flightline. But it's a very deep and promising group even aside from them. Strategically there are three advantages to breeding to stallions in their third year: (1) you are able to see foals from their first crops; (2) they will have 3yo's when you would have a yearling to sell, which gives them time to have had a first crop of 3yo's race and therefore more opportunity to have something worth talking about at the sales (or, of course, the reverse); (3) they are considerably cheaper than if you bred to them in their first year. Ten of these eleven sires stand for less than they did in 2023 and their combined 2025 stud fees are almost 30% below their entering fees. The eleven contenders are:

Flightline, 2018 Tapit, \$1m Saratoga yearling, Lane's End, \$150,000 for 2025 (\$200,000 in 2023); 8 weanlings sold, average \$655,896. Trained by John Sadler, he was 6-for-6 lifetime as a 3- and 4yo, winning the 7-furlong G1 Malibu by 11 1/2L as a 3yo, and the G1 Met Mile, Pacific Classic, and Breeders' Cup Classic (by 8 1/4L, with Olympiad running on for 2nd and Taiba 3rd) as a 4yo in 2022. His average margin of victory was almost 12L; his average Beyer was 114 and he ran 126 in the Pacific Classic and 121 in the Breeders' Cup Classic in his two races at 10 furlongs. He had a valid

excuse for not running as a 2yo, too: he was spooked while being saddled one day and collided with a door latch, which won that contest and kept him from starting as a 2yo.

Life is Good, 2018 Into Mischief, \$525k Kee Sept yearling, WinStar, \$75,000 (\$100,000); 8/\$325,625: Life Is Good killed them from the front – he led at the first call in 11 of his 12 starts of which he won nine, was second once when he was nailed at the wire by Jackie’s Warrior in the G1 Allen Jerkens in his first start for Todd Pletcher (his first three starts were for Baffert in California, but he was transferred to Pletcher after Baffert was ruled off by Churchill Downs), and was unplaced in his two tries at 10 furlongs. His first G1 win came in the 2021 Breeders’ Cup Dirt Mile at Del Mar (by 5 3/4L) and he won three 9-furlong G1’s at four – the Pegasus, Whitney, and Woodward. He gamely set the pace for Flightline in the 2022 G1 Breeders’ Cup Classic at Keeneland but 10 furlongs was too far for him and he finished 5th. He’d have been a champion for sure in almost any other year. He ran Beyers of 105+ eight times, with highs of 112 and 110.

Jackie’s Warrior, 2018 Maclean’s Music, \$95k Kee Sept yearling, Spendthrift, \$35,000 (\$50,000); 21/\$174,761: Jackie’s Warrior was named Champion Sprinter as a 3yo in 2021 and won 12 of his 18 career starts, including 5 G1 wins at two, three, and four, but ironically was 0-for-3 at the Breeders’ Cup. He was a vintage Steve Asmussen-trained sprinter – fast and tough – and the buyers liked what they saw at the weanling sales, where 21 of his first-crop weanlings averaged \$174,761, clear third on average for F2024 sires behind Flightline and Life is Good at the November sales.

Epicenter, 2019 Not This Time, \$260k Kee Sept yearling, Ashford, \$35,000 (\$45,000); 21/\$122,619: Also trained by Steve Asmussen, Epicenter was deservedly the Eclipse Champion 3yo male of 2022. Having broken his maiden at 1m in his second start as a 2yo at Churchill Downs, Epicenter wintered in New Orleans, where he ran four times, winning the Gun Runner (Listed) on December 26 as a 2yo, then after getting nipped at the wire in the G3 Lecomte, came back to post decisive wins in the G2 Risen Star and G2 Louisiana Derby. He got to the lead in the G1 Kentucky Derby only to be nailed by the 80-1 shot Rich Strike and couldn’t catch Early Voting in the G1 Preakness but came back to win the G2 Jim Dandy and the G1 Travers, decisively, by 5 1/4L over Cyberknife in a Beyer 112 to lock up the Eclipse Award. He then went off 6/1 co-second favorite with 4yo Life is Good behind 4yo Flightline in the G1 Breeders’ Cup Classic but was pulled up with a condylar fracture from which he fortunately recovered well enough to cover 262 mares at Ashford last year.

Golden Pal, 2018 Uncle Mo, homebred/private purchase, Ashford, \$20,000 (\$30,000); 32/\$110,876: Golden Pal is one of the fastest horses I’ve seen in the last twenty years, which I think we can ascribe to his dam, the rocket turf sprinter Lady Shipman, with a liberal dose of Uncle Mo class on top and trainer Wesley Ward calling the shots. He won the then-G2 (now G1) Breeders’ Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint as a 2yo and the G1 Breeders’ Cup Turf Sprint (5f) at Del Mar as a 3yo. He ran eight times at 5 1/2f on the turf at Keeneland or Saratoga, winning seven of them – four G2’s, two G3’s, and one Listed, and failed to win at that distance only in his final career start, the G1 Breeders’ Cup Turf Sprint at Keeneland, when he was never at the

aces. It's not often you see horses who really can turn on the afterburners, but when Extravagant Kid got close to him in the stretch in the G2 Woodford at Keeneland when Golden Pal was a 3yo, he literally sprinted away from him; it was jaw-dropping. Golden Pal raced for his breeder Randall Lowe as a 2yo but the Coolmore partners bought in before he ran at three. One thing Golden Pal never did successfully was ship to England: he was 0-for-3 there, though he was second to The Lir Jet as a maiden in the G2 Norfolk in 2020; his other two trips over were eminently forgettable. Not that many breeders were discouraged: Golden Pal covered 293 mares in 2023.

Olympiad, 2018 Speightstown, \$700k Kee Sept, Gainesway, \$35,000 (\$35,000), 26/\$108,980: Olympiad gained a legion of followers when he won his first five races as a 4yo in 2022: the G3 Mineshaft and three consecutive G2's- the New Orleans Classic, Alysheba, and Stephen Foster, and after running 4th to Life Is Good in the G1 Whitney, bounced back to win the G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup in his first try at 10 furlongs, then ran a distant, but bang-up second to Flightline in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic. Like a lot of these, he's got plenty of admirers of his conformation, too. He's the only one of these 11 sires who's standing for the same fee in 2025 as he did in 2023.

Corniche, 2019 Quality Road, \$1.5m OBS 2yo, Ashford, \$15,000 (\$30,000), 17/\$105,235: Corniche went 3-for-3 for Bob Baffert as a 2yo, leading all the way in all three wins. He won the G1 American Pharoah as a warm-up for the Breeders' Cup, led all the way again to win the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, and was named Eclipse Champion 2yo Male. After Baffert's ban he was sent to Todd Pletcher but made only one start

for Pletcher as a 3yo, finishing down the field in the G2 Amsterdam at Saratoga, but didn't run again. His stud fee has taken quite a haircut as he's down to \$15,000 from \$30,000 but he did cost \$1.5-million as a 2yo and was an undefeated 2yo champion.

Jack Christopher, 2019 Munnings, \$135k Fasig October yearling, Ashford, \$25,000 (\$45,000), 33/\$104,727: The best horse yet sired by Munnings, Jack Christopher was unbeaten in five starts around one turn, his only defeat coming in the 9-furlong G1 Haskell where he finished 3rd (like his sire). 'Jack' went 2-for-2 at two, winning the Champagne S. in his second start, while at three he won the G2 Pat Day Mile, the G1 Woody Stephens, and the G1 Allen Jerkens. He's a flashy chestnut in the best Raise a Native tradition, and his fee too has taken a haircut, to \$25,000 next year, 44% below his opening fee of \$45,000.

Early Voting, 2019 Gun Runner, \$200k Kee Sept yearling, Taylor Made, \$12,500 (\$25,000), 14/\$83,359: Early Voting's big day came in the 2022 G1 Preakness when he became one of 6 G1 winners in Gun Runner's first crop. He covered 191 mares at Ashford in 2023 but reportedly abruptly stopped covering and ultimately was handed over to the insurance company. But a cure evidently ensued and he covered 77 mares at Taylor Made this year. He's down again to \$12,500 for 2025, half his original fee, and if his foals are as good-looking as he is he'll be fine.

Cyberknife, 2019 Gun Runner, \$400k Fasig-Tipton yearling (Covid year sale), Spendthrift, \$20,000 (\$30,000), 23/\$79,260: Another of Gun Runner's 6 first-crop G1 winners, Cyberknife won the G1 Arkansas Derby and G1 Haskell and finished second to Epicenter

in the G1 Travers but probably ran the race of his life when making the year-old (and subsequent 2023 Horse of the Year) Cody's Wish pull out all the stops to beat him by a dirty nose in the 2022 G1 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. He's a horse with plenty of appeal, and he's not expensive.

Mandaloun, 2018 Into Mischief, homebred, Juddmonte, \$15,000 (\$25,000), 19/\$71,131: A homebred for Juddmonte, Mandaloun has the dubious distinction of very likely being the only horse whose two G1 wins both came by disqualification – the Kentucky Derby, when Medina Spirit was eventually disqualified, and the Haskell, when he went down by a dirty nose to Hot Rod Charlie, who was disqualified and placed last. Against the caveat of getting both his G1 wins by disqualification, he has the support of Juddmonte, and that counts for a lot – maybe just as much if not more than the two DQ's.

Naturally the fact that there are so many good prospects in this sire crop doesn't guarantee success. The competition among North American F2024 sires will be intense, but the fact there are so many good prospects to choose from may suppress prices to some extent for all of them; yet it is the deepest crop of genuinely exciting sire prospects I've seen in years.

Europe

Neither F2016 **Australia** nor F2017 **Gleneagles** have propelled Galileo's reputation as a sire of sires into the stratosphere but both have proven very useful sires, with APEX A Runner indexes of 2.28 and 2.02 respectively. Australia at €10,000 to cover his 11th crop tabs him as the #1 Great Value Sire in Europe for 2025, and Gleneagles at €20,000 is a great buy too.

A G3 winner as a 2yo, Australia began his 3yo campaign by running third to Night of Thunder and Kingman in the 2014 G1 English 2000 Guineas at 1m in what turned out to be the right kind of Derby prep as he then won the G1 Epsom Derby, G1 Irish Derby, and G1 Juddmonte International before closing out his year being nipped by The Grey Gatsby in the G1 Irish Champion S. Out of the outstanding seven-time G1 winner Ouija Board, Australia went to stud in 2015 for €50,000 but his stud fee has trended steadily downward until hitting this new low. But he is the #3 F2016 European sire behind Kingman and No Nay Never and is the sire of 42 BTW, 66 BT horses, including 22 GSW, 45 GSH, five G1 winners and 15 G1 horses in seven crops of racing age and as noted a 2.28 APEX A Runner Index. He's a good sire at a giveaway price next year.

Gleneagles, on the other hand, was a classic miler; he won the G1 National S. (7f) as a 2yo and the G1 English 2000 Guineas, G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, and G1 St. James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot, all at 1m, in a little over 6 weeks as a 3yo in 2015. Moreover he has a great (and a little speedier) pedigree, being out of You'resothrilling, winner of the 6-furlong G2 Cherry Hinton S. (now the Duchess of Cambridge S.) as a 2yo and a full sister to none other than Giant's Causeway. Naturally hopes were high for Gleneagles but even though he has been an extraordinarily consistent sire of G2 winners – he has 12 G2W in six crops along with his four G1 winners – this was considered disappointing. His stud fee fell as low as €15,000 and incredible as it is to believe, Gleneagles had only 18 2yo's this year (Australia, by the way, himself had only 45 3yo's). As people have realized he's a much better sire than the market was crediting him for his stud fee has now crept back up to €20,000, but he is still, in our view,

a fantastic buy at the price. Okay, maybe Coolmore has so many guns they can afford to offer good-but-not-great sires for low five-figure fees. These two sires are priced like they're just average sires but in fact both are well above average and that makes them great buys for 2025.

For all his successes Kodiak wouldn't have necessarily appealed as a sire of sires yet he's not done so badly. His F2018 sons Kodi Bear and Coulsty have been pretty successful, F2019 Ardad had dual 2yo G1 winner Perfect Power in his first crop, and F2022 Hello Youmzain has 19 winners including G3 winners Misunderstood and Electrolyte in his first crop this year and has earned a price hike at Etreham to €40,000. It's **Ardad**, who stands at Overbury Stud in England for £12,500 in 2025, who is today's subject, because he's about to have his first 2yo's after he had his first runners in 2025, and that is one of the best indicators there is of sires who are about to heat up. Mehmas had his first 2yo's after he had his first runners this year and he's shattered Kodiak's record of 61 2yo winners in a season with 67 and counting, including three 2yo G1 winners. This year, from his fourth crop, Ardad has had 16 2yo winners but whereas his current 2yo crop constituted 101 foals the average CPI of the dams of his foals was a very low 0.64. His 2023 crop has 144 foals with an average dams' CPI of 1.13 – still quite low for a commercial sire but way better than his 2022 crop – and he's had 91 yearlings sell this year for an average of \$52,132. Look for his name to be back in the news in 2025.

The inaugural G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) run at 2100m in 2005 was won by Shamardal and in the next ten years it was won by other future successful sires Le Havre, Shamardal's son Lope de Vega, Intello, The Grey Gatsby, and New Bay, which actually makes it

the best sire-making race in Europe. The 2018 winner **Study of Man** was the last of trainer Pascal Bary's six French Derby winners but the fact that Study of Man didn't win another race in seven subsequent starts (though he was twice G1-placed) didn't mark him down as an obvious candidate to add to the race's sire-making reputation; but that's where Kirsten Rausing comes in. Having previously had a successful association with the Niarchos family through 1993 (2400m) French Derby winner Hernando, Miss Rausing made a big commitment of mares to Study of Man and the results have been very impressive: when we did our Midyear APEX figures in July, Study of Man had an A Runner Index of 5.65, which is astronomical. That will come down as he has more runners but even so the graduation of Kalpana to become a G1 winner on British Champions Day sealed it: there are three very good European F2021 sires – Too Darn Hot, Blue Point, and Study of Man. Unfortunately this endorsement is somewhat retrospective as at £25,000 and with Lanwades not breeding as many mares to their stallions as, say, Coolmore, if you don't have a 2025 season to Study of Man booked by now he's very likely already book full to overflowing.

By Dubawi out of G1 Irish 1000 winner Nighttime, by Galileo, **Ghaiyyath** had a stop-start career in which he won nine of his 13 starts but also made nine of those starts as a 4yo and 5yo. He won two of three, including the prestigious G3 Autumn S. as a 2yo but ran only once at three, winning the G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange in September. He won the G1 GP von Baden at four, then went 4-for-5 at five, winning the G1 Coronation Cup, Eclipse S., and Juddmonte International. So he didn't have the profile of a sire of precocity, and along about August the picture wasn't looking so good for Ghaiyyath. But since then he has Stanhope Gardens,

a winner and 2nd in the G3 Autumn S. himself, and in October and November he had five debut winners at 1m+ including 6-length winners Gethin and Mandanaba (in France), and two trained by William Haggas including the filly Rhapsody, who only scored narrowly in a 1m maiden at Yarmouth but was very impressive in getting up to win from a seemingly impossible position. Ghaiyyath is thus well positioned to have a big year with his first 3yo's in 2025, and he was certainly a good enough racehorse that it could very well happen that way. He's standing for £20,000 in 2025.

Juddmonte went to 550,000 gns to buy a Frankel colt foal from Whitsbury Manor at the December Sale in 2020 and that colt went on to become **Chaldean**. He won the G1 Dewhurst as a 2yo and the G1 English 2000 Guineas at three to seal his spot in the Banstead Manor stallion barn, where he stood his first season for £25,000 this year. Trainer Andrew Balding decided he wanted to give Chaldean a prep before the 2000 Guineas and he lined up as the 5/4 favorite for the G3 Greenham S. at Newbury but jockey Dettori unceremoniously fell off when Chaldean was bumped as the gates opened. But he then won the Guineas convincingly over a good field including hot favorite Auguste Rodin, Coolmore's second string Little Big Bear, and future champion miler Charyn.

Little Big Bear, by 2yo specialist No Nay Never, meanwhile dropped back to 6 furlongs after the Guineas to win the G2 Sandy Lane S. as a prep for Royal Ascot's G1 Commonwealth Cup but was defeated in that race by Shaquille who came back to win the G1 July Cup over older horses, in which Little Big Bear finished last of eight and was then retired. But Little Big Bear's prospects as a sire don't

rest on his 3yo form but his 2yo form, in which he won four of five starts including the G1 6-furlong Phoenix S. by 7L over Persian Force, running RPR 121 in what was the most impressive 2yo race run in Europe in 2022. No Nay Never really is one of the best sire of 2yo's in the 21st century (2.86 2yo index) and Little Big Bear is arguably No Nay Never's very best 2yo. He will stand his second season for €20,000 in 2025.

El Caballo may not be a name which is instantly recognizable to a lot of breeders but he's a sneakily interesting prospect standing at England's Culworth Grounds Stud, by Havana Grey's sire Havana Gold out of a Showcasing mare. Havana Gold was a son of the noted staying influence Teofilo but he was out of a very fast mare named Jessica's Dream, by Green Desert's son Desert Style, and Havana Gold & sons have clearly thrown to Jessica's Dream in speed aptitude rather than to Teofilo. Trained by Karl Burke, El Caballo ripped off six wins in a row as a 2yo and early 3yo, culminating in the G2 Sandy Lane S., and went off joint-favorite for the G1 Commonwealth Cup but was never at the races. But Sophie Buckley went out and recruited him for her stud and he covered 100 mares in 2024 and can be considered "the workingman's Havana Grey". For those who like the idea of Havana Grey but for whom he's out of reach, El Caballo is a viable alternative as is, of course, Havana Grey's G1-winning 2yo Vandeeek (see below).

Europe: The Class of '26

There are any number of interesting sire prospects retiring in Europe in 2025, headed by the two superstars for Coolmore, 3yo **City of Troy** (€75,000) and 4yo **Auguste Rodin** (€30,000). Is City of Troy 'great value' at €75,000? Well he won six of his eight starts including the G1 Dewhurst as a 2yo and the G1 Epsom Derby, Eclipse, and Juddmonte International as a 3yo. You'll have perhaps seen Coolmore's ad where we're quoted as saying he is only the 13th sire prospect in the last 30 years to score 9/9 on our Stallion Spectator Ratings (SSR) predictive scale which basically means they have a 75% chance of becoming a top 10% sire; plus he's only the second horse, after Too Darn Hot, to score 9/9 plus 7/7 on our 2yo form predictive scale. So yes, he's great value because he has a 75% chance of becoming a Top 10% sire. Being by Justify out of G1 winner Together Forever, by Galileo, doesn't lessen his appeal either.

Coolmore's Australia at €10,000 for 2025 is the best value sire in Europe, but Auguste Rodin at €30,000 is

a close second. By Deep Impact out of the three-time G1-winning Galileo mare Rhododendron, 'Auguste' won six G1 races from 1m-1 1/2m: the Futurity at Doncaster at two; the Epsom and Irish Derbies, Irish Champion S., and Breeders' Cup Turf at three; and the Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot this year as a 4yo. He narrowly misses scoring 9/9 himself and €30,000 seems an insanely reasonable price (if that's not an oxymoron) for a horse of his class and pedigree.

At a significantly lower level there are only three sires retiring in England for £7,000+ for 2025, but on the plus side there is something to like about all three. The most expensive of the three is **Vandeek**, from the first crop of Havana Grey, who goes to Cheveley Park for £15,000. After breaking the clock at the April Tattersalls breeze-ups he topped the sale at 625,000 gns and went on to go 4-for-4 at 6 furlongs as a 2yo, including the G2 Richmond and G1 Prix Morny and Middle Park. He only ran twice at three, finishing third both times, but he'd made the point: he was case closed the best European 6-furlong 2yo of 2023 and his £15,000 opening fee seems eminently reasonable.

Can a son of Tasleet (by Showcasing), unceremoniously sold to India before the 2024 breeding season, make a sire? He can if he's **Bradsell**, who goes to The National Stud for £10,000. Why? Because he won the G2 Coventry at Royal Ascot at 6 furlongs as a 2yo, then dropped to 5 furlongs at which distance he won the G1 King's Stand at Royal Ascot as a 3yo and proved himself the best 5-furlong sprinter in Europe in 2024 with wins in the G1 Nunthorpe and G1 Flying Five. He was a first-class sprinter. Finally, in England, there is Night of Thunder's first good son to retire, Isaac Shelby, who goes to Newsells Park for just £7,000. He won the G2 Superlative at Newmarket as a 2yo and the

G3 Greenham as a 3yo for trainer Brian Meehan, both at 7 furlongs, and was beaten a short neck in the 2023 G1 French 2000 Guineas. Good colt.

The leading sire prospect retiring in France in 2025 is **Charyn**, the best miler in Europe this year and by Dark Angel out of a Kodiak mare, no less, who retires to Sumbe's Montfort et Preaux for €35,000. Trained by Roger Varian, Charyn always kept good company: he won the 1200m G2 Criterium de Maisons-Lafitte as a 2yo, then won the G3 Greenham and ran 4th, 3rd, and 3rd to Paddington in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, the G1 St. James's Palace S., and the G1 Sussex respectively (that alone gives **Paddington** an Honorable Mention). But Charyn really came into his own this year when he won his own legion of admirers with his consistency, toughness, and class: barring his 5th-place swansong in Japan, he ran seven times in Europe in 2024, winning five and running second in the other two, including wins in the G1 Queen Anne at Royal Ascot, the G1 Jacques le Marois, and the G1 Queen Elizabeth S, on British Champions Day.

Another prospect retiring in France who gained legions of admirers for his class and consistency, including this observer, is Metropolitan, by Zarak, who goes to the Haras d'Etream for €15,000. Trained by the up-and-coming Mario Baratti for a group including American bloodstock agent Pete Bradley, **Metropolitan** surprised a few people when winning the G1 French 2000 Guineas at 24/1 but he confirmed that was no fluke by subsequently running 3rd to Rosallion in the G1 St. James's Palace S. and 2nd to Charyn in the G1 Jacques le Marois. €15,000 is a great price point for him; he's a very taking individual and gives breeders a great chance to breed to a real class 3yo for very reasonable money.

Finally, I can't resist throwing in a word for the Coolmore-raced **River Tiber**, by the amazing Wootton Bassett, who goes to the Haras de la Huderie for €5,500. He was out in April and won his first three races, culminating in the G2 Coventry at Royal Ascot in June. He then ran third behind Vandeeek in both the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park and was fancied to win the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf but was scratched by the vets which opened the door for his stablemate Unquestionable (also by Wootton Bassett). River Tiber came back to run 3rd to Rosallion in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas but the chips didn't fall for him after that and he was unplaced in his last three races, the G3 Jersey at Royal Ascot, the G1 July Cup, and the G1 Foret. But he's sure reasonably priced and just on the form book he was a pretty fair racehorse, and I've a suspicion he might have been a few pounds better than the form book shows.

TATTERSALLS DECEMBER SALE RECORD PROPELS EUROPEAN MIXED SALES TO NEW HIGHS

With the Tattersalls December Sale recording a record gross of 134.7-million gns, cracking their 2022 record by over 14-million gns with 80 fewer lots sold, the 2024 European mixed sales recorded sales of over €335.7-million, breaking the record of €306.9-million also set in 2022; but with 502 fewer horses sold (10% fewer), the European mixed sale average of €71,109 for 4,581 lots sold was 18% higher than the 2022 average of €60,381. Combined with \$296.7-million in North American 2nd-half mixed sales – about \$20-million below 2022 - the 2024 North American and European 2nd-half mixed sales grossed €638.6-million for 7,065 lots sold, about €1.4-million less than the 2022 high-water mark of €640-million, but with nearly 600 fewer sold the combined average of €90,400 was 8% higher than 2022's €83,591 average and included no fewer than 50 seven-figure sales (in local currencies) of fillies and mares.

With the full sister to Chaldean selling to AMO Racing for a European record-equaling 2.5-million gns for a foal, **Frankel** was the leading European (or American) sire by 2024 weanling average with five averaging the equivalent of US\$1,518,640. Among sires with their first foals in 2024, Shadwell's **Baaeed**, by Sea The Stars, won 10 of his 11 starts at three and four and was the outstanding prospect to retire in Europe in 2023. There were 8 foals by Baaeed offered at Tattersalls and Arqana and all 8 sold, for an average of US\$316,093, with Coolmore's dual 2yo 6-furlong G1 winner **Blackbeard** (by No Nay Never) a distant second by average for first-year foal sires, 27 Blackbeard foals selling for an average of \$91,504. Among sires who covered their first mares in 2024, Coolmore's 4-time G1W **Paddington** (by Siyouni) had four in-foal mares average \$356,179, ahead of Darley's 5-time G1W **Modern Games** (by Dubawi, 12 mares in foal averaged \$257,534), and Juddmonte's G1 Dewhurst and English 2000 winner **Chaldean** (by Frankel, 19/\$196,552).

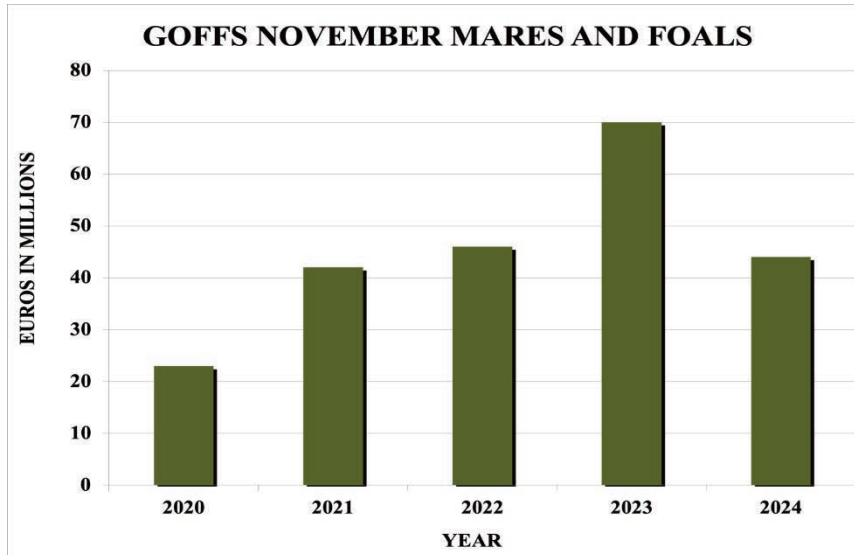

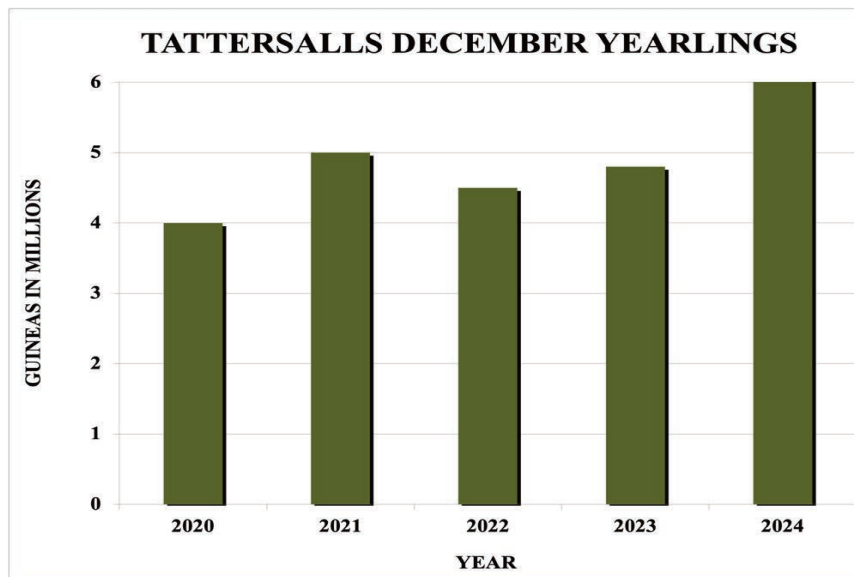

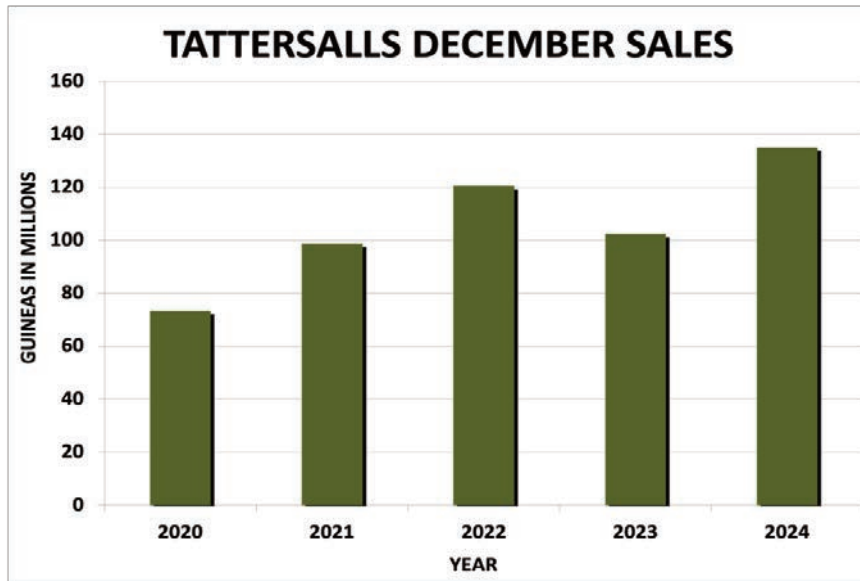
NORTH AMERICAN AND EUROPEAN SALES THROUGH DECEMBER 12, 2024



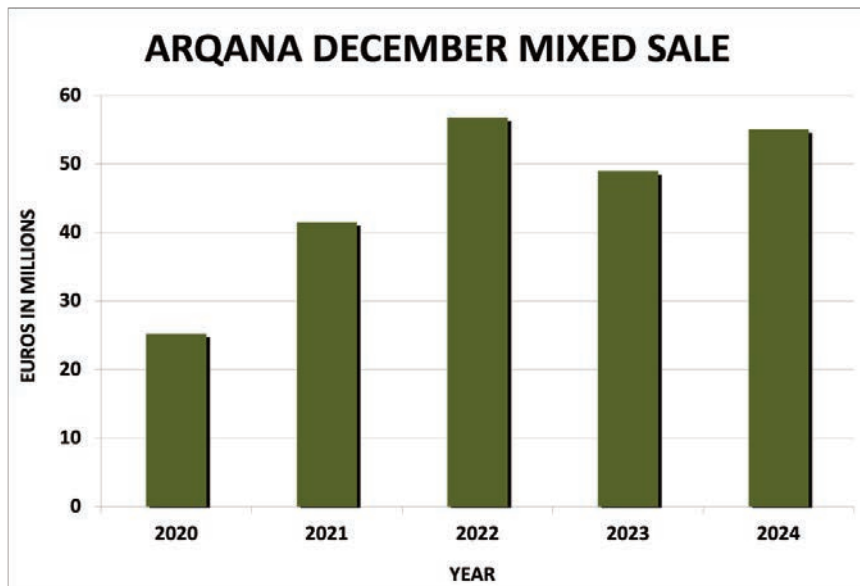

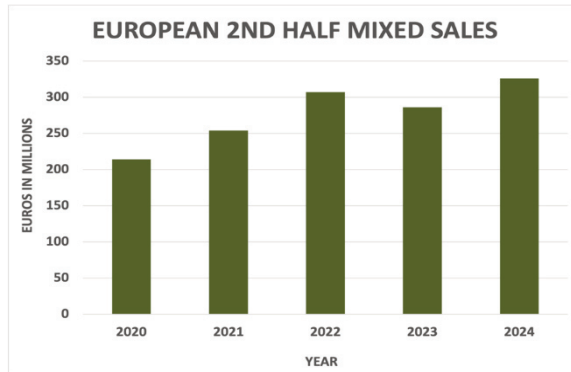

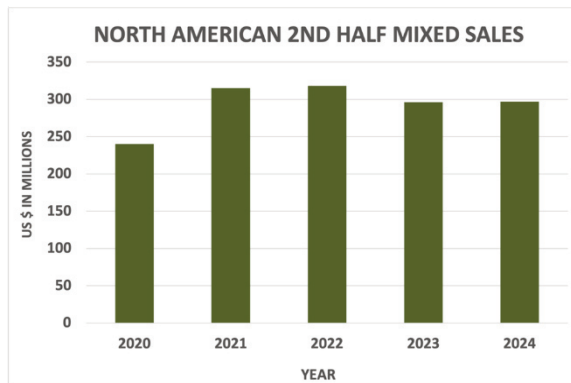

Newgate's Stay Inside and Wild Ruler and Shuttler St Mark's Basilica Also have 50+

It's Coolmore and Newgate for the highest representation among F2023 Southern Hemisphere sires with their first yearlings selling at the 2025 Australasian yearling sales, with two each of the four sires with 50+ catalogued in the first three sales – Magic Millions January (Books 1 & 2), New Zealand's Karaka Sale (Books 1 & 2) and Inglis Classic in February. Coolmore's sales debutant **Home Affairs**, by 3-time champion sire I Am Invincible and winner, appropriately, of the 1200m G1 Coolmore Stud S. for 3yo's as well as the 1000m G1 Lightning S. over 'olders', has the highest number of yearlings catalogued by any sire, not just first-year sires, with 91 catalogued across the three sales, including 63 in Magic Millions Book 1 – the most by any sire in that key season-opening book. Coolmore also stands shuttler

St Mark's Basilica, by Siyouni, whose 64 first-crop Northern Hemisphere yearlings averaged \$230,864; he has 55 catalogued across the three sales, including 27 in Magic Millions Book 1. Newgate stands 2021 G1 Golden Slipper winner (over a fast-finishing Anamoe) **Stay Inside**, from the first crop by sire sensation Extreme Choice; and **Wild Ruler**, by Snitzel out of the good American racemare Gypsy Robin; Stay Inside has 67 catalogued through the three sales, 42 at Magic Millions Book 1, Wild Ruler has 62 catalogued, 33 at MM Book 1. Other sires with 60+ catalogued across the three books are New Zealand's **Proisir** (77, including 53 at Karaka Book 1) and **Satono Aladdin** (63, of which 40 in Karaka Book 1); Newgate's **Capitalist** (68, of which 34 in MM Book 1); and Kia Ora Stud's **Farnan**, the 2020 G1 Golden Slipper winner by Extreme Choice's sire Not A Single Doubt and promising sire with his first 2yo's racing this season. He has 62 catalogued, 26 in MM Book 1. Champion Sires **I Am Invincible** (3 times) and **Snitzel** (4 times) have 59 (52 in MM 1) and 48 (42 in MM Book 1) catalogued respectively, while Champion Sire In Waiting **Zoustar** has 47 catalogued, 39 in MM Book 1. Nine-time Champion NZ sire **Savabeel** has 53 catalogued, 46 in Karaka Book 1.

Figures for these tables were compiled for us by Arion Pedigrees through racing of December 6 and include an interesting metric not seen on other leading sire lists: the sire's average winning distance (AWD), expressed in meters (200m = 1 furlong effectively). Note, for example, of the leading North American F2019 sires, #1 **Gun Runner** (\$58.7m, 35 BTW) has an average winning distance of 1478m (approximately 7.39 furlongs), whereas #2 **Practical Joke** (\$34.9m, 24 BTW) has an AWD of 1292m (6.46f), and #3 **Arrogate** (\$30.2m, 27 BTW) has an AWD of 1589m (7.95f).

On the NA F2020 sire list (1st 4yo's 2024), **Justify** (\$27.4m, 30 BTW) is #1, with **Good Magic** (\$22.8m, BTW) #2. **Omaha Beach** (\$9.6m, 12 BTW) leads the NA F2021 (1st 3yo's) list, and the F2022 NA Freshman Sire List is a three-way tussle. On December 6 **Vekoma** had a slight lead over **McKinzie** and **Tiz The Law**, but a week later McKinzie had edged to the front. Vekoma is the runaway leader by first-crop 2yo winners, though, with 37.

Churchill (\$14.4m, 21 BTW, 1797m AWD) and **Zarak** (\$11m, 27 SW, 1982m AWD – almost 10 furlongs) are the leading two European F2019 sires with their first 5yo's in 2024. **Havana Grey** (\$9.7m, 22 BTW, 1237m) is the leading F2020 European sire, ahead of **Saxon Warrior** (1724m), **Cracksman** (1971m), and **Sioux Nation** (1395m), all over \$7m in cumulative progeny earnings. **Blue Point** (\$7.9m, 12 BTW, 1289m) and **Too Darn Hot** (\$5m, 12 BTW, 1600m) are the top two European F2021 sires, although Too Darn Hot (\$7.1m) is way in front as the leading second-season sire in Australia (see below). **Sergei Prokofiev** (\$1m) is the

leading Freshman Sire in Europe, ahead of a group including **Pinatubo** (\$811k), **Kameko** (\$794k), **Sands of Mali** (\$722k), **Hello Youmzain** (\$714k), and **Mohaather** (\$705k).

Yarraman Park's **Hellbent** (\$21.1m) has edged ahead of Newgate's **Russian Revolution** (\$19.9m) among F2019 Australasian sires with first 5yo's now midway through the 2024/25 season. Among Australasian F2020 sires with their first 4yo's, Coolmore's **Justify** (\$11.4m, 1388m AWD versus 1549m in the NH) leads Darley's **Harry Angel** (\$10.7m), Widden's **Trapeze Artist** (\$9.4m), and Arrowfield's **The Autumn Sun** (\$9m). Darley's **Too Darn Hot** (\$7.1m), as mentioned, is the leading F2021 Australasian sire, but Yulong's **Alabama Express** (\$3.8m) and **Pierata** (\$2.9m), Arrowfield's **Castelvecchio** (\$3.08m), and Newgate's **Tassort** (\$3.05m) are all also doing well. **Blue Point** (\$2.2m) is #6 on this list, with no ANZ-bred BTW yet, but 6 BTH, and he is improving. Another son of Dundee, himself a champion son of High Chaparral who is siring a good number of class horses, is **Super Seth** (\$1.8m), the leading second-season sire in NZ, where he stands at Waikato Stud. The leading Australasian Freshman Sire by progeny earnings so far is Kia Ora's **Farnan** (\$607k), ahead of Yulong's **Lucky Vega** (\$339k) and Vinery's **Ole Kirk** (\$239k), who since December 6 has a second BTW and edges past Lucky Vega for second spot; and Wootton Bassett (\$230k), who is Leading Sire of 2yo's in Europe this year, including 10 2yo GSW, in his first European Coolmore crop. The ANZ 2yo's are only halfway through their first season, of course, only the equivalent of June in the Northern Hemisphere.
