

Thoroughbred Market Report

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- There have been 3 important sales this month, and all three – Inglis' Sydney Easter Yearling Sale in Australia, Tattersalls' Craven 2yo In Training Sale in Newmarket, and the OBS Spring 2yo Sale in Ocala – all saw somewhat surprising strength.
- In the Sydney sale April 6 & 7, 339 yearlings grossed A\$151,815,000 and averaged A\$447,832. The gross was under 1% short of the record 2022 gross (which had 44 more horses sold) while the average was up 5% from last year. There were 25 seven-figure yearlings, headed by an A\$3-million colt from the first crop of Home Affairs; a A\$2.7-million colt by Snitzel; and an A\$2.6-million filly by Zoustar bought by Kentuckian John Stewart.
- The Tattersalls' Craven 2yo sale saw a renewal of Kia Joorabchian's AMO Racing's assault on the top tier which had been a feature of last year's October 1 yearling sale. Godolphin bought a 1.4-million gns Acclamation colt on Tuesday night only for AMO to go to 1.75-million gns for a Havana Grey colt on Wednesday night. The sale finished up with a record 18,804,000 gross, +29% from last year.
- The OBS Spring (April) 2yo Sale saw an 8% gain in gross and 7% gain in average with a record nine 2yo's selling for \$1m+, three of which were by Coolmore Ashford's second-crop sire Tiz The Law. There were thus 16 two-year-olds to sell for seven figures between the March and April sales. But the clearance rate from the catalogues remains at a difficult 53% and the April median was down 7%, from \$70,000 to \$65,000.
- Sire averages after the three sales. **Snitzel** (68 sold, average A\$664,838) had the highest average at this year's ANZ yearling sales through the Easter Sale, among ten sires who averaged over A\$500,000. **Gun Runner**, with eight sold averaging \$866,250, has the highest average at the North American 2yo sales so far. **Tiz The Law** (26/\$335,192) has made a big impression and first-year sires **Independence Hall** (24, \$166,416) – like Tiz The Law by Tapit's son Constitution – and **Beau Liam** (22, \$115,886) had impressive returns on initial stud fees of \$10,000 and \$6,000 respectively.
- Announced 2025 stud fees to date for Australasian sires. **Extreme Choice** (A\$330,000) has the highest stud fee in Australasia, while **Too Darn Hot** returns for A\$275,000. Darley's **Broadsiding** (A\$66,000), by Too Darn Hot, and Coolmore's **Switzerland** (A\$60,500), by Snitzel, are the highest-priced debuting stallions announced so far.

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INTRODUCTION:

The month of April has seen three major thoroughbred sales on three different continents and to the general surprise, relief, and delight of sellers, buyers, and sales company officials there have been price rises and positive results from all three. This month, at the Wm Inglis Easter Yearling Sale in Sydney, the Tattersalls Craven 2yo Sale in Newmarket, and the OBS Spring 2yo supermarket in Ocala, a total of 1,095 horses have sold for approximately US\$212 million. That's only about a \$12 million (7%) increase over last year but it was overall all good news for the worldwide thoroughbred auction marketplace, which was feeling shaky going in.

First up was the **Sydney Easter Yearling Sale** April 6-7 in Australia, the final major 2025 yearling sale in Australasia, which had kicked off at Magic Millions in January. There was a 16% reduction in the number catalogued in Sydney, from 500 in 2024 to 421 catalogued this year. The 2024 sale had seen a 10% increase in average from 2023 to A\$426,447 while the gross had come within A\$1-million of the record 2022 gross of A\$153-million, when 79% of the 487 yearlings catalogued had sold; that figure dropped to 71% last year. With the reduction in the catalogue and general nervousness about the market we projected the sale might gross closer to A\$125-million but the sale rebounded to 80.5% sold/catalogued and grossed A\$151,185,000, literally only a \$225,000 drop in gross from last year with 16% fewer catalogued and a consequent 5% gain in average to A\$447,832. When we take all the metrics into consideration we felt the sale had actually performed 20% above expectations, including 25 A\$1m+ yearlings, headed by a \$3-million colt from the first crop of Coolmore's son of I Am Invincible, Home Affairs; a \$2.7-million Snitzel colt; and a \$2.6-million Zosutar filly bought by American John Stewart's Resolute Racing. Leading overall buyer in Sydney was Coolmore Australia's Tom Magnier who spent A\$10,400,000 on six colts by Snitzel, I Am Invincible, and Wootton Bassett and one filly. Ten different sires averaged over A\$500,000 at the sale, led by four-time champion sire Snitzel, who averaged A\$718,787 for 31 sold.

Tattersalls' Craven Sale of 2yo's was held over two evenings after racing April 15-16. That sale had averaged 137,590 guineas in 2024 when 106 two-year-olds grossed 14,584,500, but the gross had been 15,357,500 gns in 2023 when 126

two-year-olds sold. Didn't matter; at last year's Tattersalls October 1 yearling sale – the top yearling sale in Europe – Kia Joorabchian's AMO Racing crashed the list of top-level buyers, topping the sale with a 4.4-million gns Frankel filly and a 4.3-million gns Wootton Bassett colt (AMO and Godolphin bought four each for 2-million gns plus) and the sale set new records for gross and average. Godolphin and AMO were back in action at the Craven sale: on Tuesday night Sheikh Mohammed's team set a new record of 1.4-million guineas for an Acclamation colt, but the next night AMO broke that record when paying 1.75-million gns for a colt by Havana Grey. The sale finished with 119 two-year-olds (65.4% of the catalogue, 6.5% higher than in 2024) grossing a record 18,804,000 gns (+29% from last year) and a record 158,017 average (+18%) and also saw a 25% jump in the median from 80,000 gns last year to 100,000 gns, which was not quite a record as the median had reached 110,000 gns in 2017.

The **OBS Spring 2yo Sale** held over four days April 15-18 is more of a 'supermarket' sale, with 1,207 two-year-olds catalogued. The OBS March 2yo Sale is slightly more of a high-end affair and finished largely on a par with the March 2024 sale as 432 two-year-olds sold (53.1% of the 814 catalogued). That sale had seven \$1-million-plus 2yo's, topped by a \$3-million Gun Runner colt bought by Zedan Racing. The April sale saw a record nine 2yo's bring \$1m-plus, taking the two-sale total to 16, and 637 two-year-olds (52.8% of those catalogued) sold through the ring for an 8% increase in gross to \$88,761,500 and a 7% gain in average, to \$139,343. There were two downsides, however: only just over half those catalogued sold through the ring, and the median dropped by 7%, from \$70,000 to \$65,000. For the two sales combined, just under 53% (1,069) of the 2,021 two-year-olds catalogued were sold – which means it's a tough market in which pinhookers and consignors really need home runs to come out ahead – for a total of US\$154,577,000 (+4% from last year) and a \$144,599 average (+3%). But the three key April thoroughbred auctions were up, not down, which considering US tariffs, real and threatened, and that the Dow Jones Industrial Average is down 8% from the start of the year, must qualify as good news for the thoroughbred world. Whatever is happening or going to happen in the outside world, it hasn't stopped people buying \$212-million worth of horses at these three important sales this month.

SECTION 1: AUSTRALASIAN SALES

NINE SIRES WITH 10+ SOLD AVERAGE A\$300K+ AT ANZ YEARLING SALES

Through racing of April 19 Coolmore Australia's **Pride of Dubai** still held a lead of ~\$600,000 over Zoustar on Australia's General Sire List, with four-time champion sire Snitzel having moved into a clear 3rd after the 2yo filly Marhooba became his third G1 Golden Slipper winner last month. An Australian-bred son of Street Cry out of a Danehill mare who won the G1 Blue Diamond (1200m) and the G1 Sires Produce (1400m) for his breeder, Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa, as a 2yo in 2015, Pride of Dubai owes his current position to three 7yo's: the mares Bella Nipotina, who won the A\$20m Everest earlier this season, and Pride of Jenni, who has only two G2 wins this season but won four G1's and A\$8.2m last season, when Pride of Dubai finished up #4 on the Sire List; and the Northern Hemisphere-bred gelding Dubai Honour, who won his second G1 in Australia earlier this month. Pride of Dubai has never been a very commercial stallion (he's had four yearlings average \$40,000 at the ANZ sales so far this year) but however you cut the cake there can't possibly be a better buy for breeders than the A\$27,500 fee just announced by Coolmore for Pride of Dubai in 2025.

So Pride of Dubai does not figure among the nine stallions with 10+ sold who have averaged over A\$300,000 at the ANZ yearling sales this year. Arrowfield's four-time champion sire **Snitzel** tops the charts with 68 yearlings which averaged A\$664,838. Juddmonte's superstar sire **Frankel**, who has never shuttled but covers mares Southern Hemisphere time, had 18 yearlings average A\$544,389, followed by

Yarraman Park's **I Am Invincible** (74/A\$538,643), champion sire the last three seasons; Newgate's brilliant but sub-fertile **Extreme Choice** (28/\$506,786), who's had the winner of the G1 Golden Slipper and the G1 Melbourne Cup in his first two crops; and Widden's Stud **Zoustar** (68/A\$488,971), who should still be able to outmuscle Pride of Dubai and claim his first sire championship in the remaining three months of the season. Former champion sire **Written Tycoon** (39/\$403,359), **Wootton Bassett** (66/A\$362,986), leading Australian second-crop sire **Too Darn Hot** (51/\$322,113), who returns to Australia for 2025, and top first-crop yearling sire **Home Affairs** (102/A\$309,526), a G1 winner at 1000m and 1200m by I Am Invincible who stands at Coolmore Australia, round out the list of sires who averaged A\$300k+ at the ANZ yearling sales.

Nine first-crop yearling sires (F2023) have averaged ~A\$100,000. After Home Affairs the #2 F2023 sire on average is Newgate's **Stay Inside** (68/A\$237,740), the aforementioned G1 Golden Slipper winner from Extreme Choice's first crop. #'s 3 and 4 are respectively Coolmore and Darley shuttlers **St Mark's Basilica** (56/A\$176,123) and **Pinatubo** (50/A\$174,429), with New Zealand's Cambridge Stud's G1-winning son of Snitzel, **Sword of State** (37/A\$156,093), Darley shuttlers **Palace Pier** (25/A\$136,068) and **Victor Ludorum** (7/A\$103,751), New Zealand's Waikato Stud's **Noverre** (36/\$102,658), by their nine-time (about to be ten-time) champion NZ sire Savabeel, and Newgate's **Wild Ruler** (61/A\$99,926), another G1 winner by Snitzel and out of the good US 7-furlong 2x G2 winner Gypsy Robin, all also averaging A\$100,000+ (or near enough).

SECTION 2: AUSTRALASIAN STUD FEES/ NEW SIRES FOR 2025

As of April 21, 2025 the roster of new southern hemisphere stallions features 21 first-year sires across Australia, New Zealand, and South Africa. Australia currently lists 13 new sires for the 2025 season, including standout entries like Broadsiding (A\$66,000) and Switzerland (A\$60,500), while New Zealand has three so far led by Auguste Rodin (NZ\$30,000). South Africa also introduces three new stallions, with Point Lonsdale topping the region at ZAR30,000.

16 SEVEN-FIGURE OBS 2YO'S IN 2 SALES: TAPIT, CONSTITUTION, AND UNCLE MO

Eleven different stallions sired the 16 two-year-olds who have sold for \$1m+ at the OBS March and Spring April sales and it's noticeable that Tapit's name comes up five times, and Uncle Mo's four times, in the sire lines. **Tapit** had a \$1-million colt himself at the April sale. His son **Constitution**, who sits #7 on the North American General Sire list this year having finished #5 last year, had nine 2yo's average \$328,556 though none for seven figures (high \$675,000), but does have two sons who have seven-figure 2yo's: Coolmore Ashford's **Tiz The Law**, who had THREE seven-figure 2yo's (two colts, one filly) and another colt for \$825,000 and has averaged \$335,192 for 26 two-year-olds sold (from a \$35,000 stud fee); and WinStar's first-crop \$10,000 stallion **Independence Hall**, who had a \$1-million colt in March and a \$700,000 colt in April and has averaged \$166,416 for 24 sold. These 2yo's are from Tiz The Law's second crop; his first crop maybe hasn't got the headlines of Vekoma or McKinzie but he's sired six BTW and has a live G1 Kentucky Derby contender in G2 Louisiana Derby winner Tiztastic who by the way is inbred 3x2 to Tapit, being out of a Tapit mare!

From the time he broke the records for a freshman sire in 2015 we suspected the late great **Uncle Mo** might turn out to be a big influence – he's revived a small but mighty branch of Nasrullah through Grey Sovereign via Caro, Siberian Express, In Excess, and Indian Charlie – and so it

is proving. He had a \$1-million colt himself in April; his son **Nyquist** had a \$1-million colt in March and a \$1,050,000 colt in April; and another son, the first-crop sprinter **Yaupon**, had a \$1.3-million colt in April having had another colt make \$875,000 in March en route to a \$255,189 average for 37 two-year-olds sold.

The leading first-crop sire at the 2yo sales so far, though, is Hill 'n' Dale's **Charlatan**, with 25 two-year-olds averaging \$271,293, with Spendthrift's Yaupon (\$255,189) second and Darley's **Maxfield** (19/\$223,842), who had two seven-figure 2yo's in March, third. WinStar's **Independence Hall** (24/\$166,416) as mentioned in fourth by 2yo sale average, followed by Darley's **Essential Quality** (13/\$159,230), Airdrie's wunderkind **Beau Liam** (22/\$115,886 off a \$6,000 fee), and Taylor Made's Horse of the Year **Knicks Go** (20/\$105,153).

With a \$3-million colt having topped the March sale and another \$1.45-million colt in April, Three Chimneys' **Gun Runner** leads sires of 2yo's on average so far, with eight sold averaging \$866,250. Fair enough; whenever Into Mischief's reign as Champion Sire is over (maybe not just yet), Gun Runner is odds-on to succeed him.
